CLADDING FAQs



- 1) Can the Deckorators Mineral-Based Composite Decking be used as cladding? Yes, our MBC decking can be installed as wall cladding in a vertical and horizontal direction for residential applications. Please contact your Deckorators representative about commercial applications.
- 2) Does Deckorators MBC Decking used as cladding have comprehensive installation instructions to explain what is required to apply the cladding properly? Yes, there is a 3 page summary complete with figures to help with mounting the cladding.
- **3)** Can I use hidden fasteners with my Deckorators MBC Decking used as Cladding? Yes, we sell a hidden fastener known as the Stowaway clip that can easily be used to mount the slotted deck boards. NOTE: The Stowaway Clip can only be used when the long length of the boards are in the horizontal direction.
- 4) Is it possible to attach Deckorators MBC Decking used as clading by applying screws to face of the board without showing the screw head? Yes, we offer a screw made by Starborn known as the Pro-Plug system. This system allows you to counterbore a face screw with the head of the screw partially into the board with the tip of the screw fully ingaged into a furring strip and then cover the head of the screw hole with a plastic cap that is the same color as the cladding.
- 5) Is it possible to use pressure-treated Southern Yellow Pine furring strips that are 1.5" wide by 0.75" thick? Yes. This is acceptable since it is treated to resist rot and decay.
- **6) What size Deckorators MBC Decking can I use as cladding?** Deckorators offers three different widths: 3.5", 5.5", and 7.25" and they can be bought in 12', 16' and 20' foot lengths.
- 7) Can the Deckorators MBC Decking used as cladding be attached to the wall with the long length of the board running vertically or at an angle? Yes, you can do this however this can only be achieved by face-screwing into the furring strips. NOTE: The Stowaway clip does not work with the the long length of the boards installed vertically or at an angle.
- 8) When two boards are placed end-to-end, are there special instructions for fastening along with gapping requirements? Yes, there are easy-to-read details in the installation instructions that tell what to do in this scenario.
- 9) Do the 1.5" wide by 0.75" thick furring strips need to be attached to the vertical 2x4 studs? No the furring strips spaced at a maximum of 24" on/center are only required to be fastened to 7/16" thick rated OSB or plywood wall sheathing.
- **10) What type of screw is used to attach the furring strip to the wall sheathing?** Since the exterior wall cladding is out in the elements, it is required to use a #10 x 2" long Starborn Epoxy-Coated or 316 Stainless Steel Screw.
- 11) The building inspector is requesting technical information on this product and application. What do I give the inspector? Deckorators has partnered with a 3rd party evaluation report writer known as ICC-ES who has issued ESR-4548 showing specific engineering details to help the inspector accept the product very easily.
